EMMAUS is a method of Christian renewal in the church. Individuals recommended for Emmaus should be currently active in a local church and have a desire to deepen their faith and become closer to Christ in their discipleship. As a sponsor, you are required to provide information to the applicant to assist him/her in the decision to attend a weekend, to help him/her enter fully into the Emmaus fellowship after the weekend, to provide prayer and other support, and to provide transportation to and from **Camp Easter Seals**. Please be sure to encourage BOTH husband and wife to attend Emmaus. A checklist of sponsorship responsibilities is included on the next page of this application. The total cost of this weekend is \$140.00 including a \$40.00 deposit which is due with this application. The balance of \$100.00 is due prior to the Walk.

Sponsor's Checklist





Sponsorship is the most important role in the Walk to Emmaus community. As a sponsor you will reflect God's personal love and commitment to the Pilgrim. God passes His love from person to person and you will underline that fact by passing on your Emmaus experience to another.

Your aim in <u>sponsorship</u> should not be to get all your friends to go or to fix everyone's problems, but to build up the Body of Christ. Emmaus' purpose is to bring renewal to Christians so that they will go home and bring renewal to their homes, churches, and communities.

Do you know someone who shows potential in Christian leadership? Do you know someone who yearns for answers to their questions and to find a deeper faith? Then that is who you should sponsor!

Anyone who has participated in the Walk to Emmaus (or other recognized Fourth Day Movements) may sponsor a Pilgrim. The only additional requirement is that you are confident you can fulfill all <u>sponsorship responsibilities</u>. (See list below)

1. Prayer

Release control and expectation Discern whether to sponsor and whom Remember the "equal commitment rule" that encourages participation of both spouses. Continue prayer on and through all the next steps

2. Select a Pilgrim to Sponsor

Traditional Christian Belief Promote church leadership and Christian community Consider disposition (e.g., ability to sit several hours, whether loud, argumentative)

- 3. Invitation right time and place
- Application process fill out, send in the Pilgrim's application and separate Sponsor's Form, both available at http://www.swvaemmaus.org/ Don't hesitate to indicate scholarship need; nobody should be discouraged from sponsorship because of financial concerns.
- 5. Agape Letters contact family member to solicit letters from family and friends. Begin the process several weeks before the Walk to allow a hand written letter or note. Also give the writers the option of emailing to you so that you may print and put in envelope. Be sure to write FAMILY on outside of envelope to aid Agape team.
- 6. Contact Pilgrim with arrangements for travel, suggestions on packing; include your phone # to Pilgrim's family; offer to help Pilgrim with routine chores.
- 7. Take Pilgrim to Camp Easter Seals, New Castle VA (meal on the way), assist with check in, walk around the grounds to identify cabin, introduce friends, loosen up. After send-off, stay for sponsors' hour and pray over the Pilgrim's Cross.
- 8. During the weekend:
 - A. Check on family, tasks for Pilgrim (feed pets? water plants? pick up mail or newspaper?)
 - B. Deliver letters to box at camp by Candlelight (make sure full name on envelope, may be bundled together)
 - C. Attend Saturday candlelight
 - D. Help in the Background
 - E. Attend Closing and deliver your Pilgrim back home
- 9. Go with Pilgrim to fourth-day meeting(Walk reunion)
- 10. Encourage participation in the community, upcoming walks (provide specific contact information and opportunity descriptions)
- 11. Discuss after the Walk Reunion the importance of a Reunion Group in their life. Assist your Pilgrim to find or start a new Reunion Group even if that means leaving your present Group for a period of time to help start a new group.
- 12. Teach the Pilgrim in turn to become a sponsor and continue participation
